- It has been a busy summer at Alliance Education Center. Extended School Year (ESY) was very successful. Students participated in community outings to local parks, grocery stores, Feed My Starving Children, and community events. Some classes made delicious food and shared with the office. Lastly, and probably the biggest accomplishment of ESY, is that a from Farmington successfully completed graduation requirements. A small ceremony and celebration was held on Thursday, August 3, 2017 attended by previous staff, administration, and the student's family. What a huge success!
- A graduation celebration was held on July 21, 2017 for two students at Riverside School. Plans for the two graduates began in March when the discussion began regarding whether both students would be eligible to graduate in 2017.
